Re: Impending retirements of our Superintendent and our 7-12 Principal

We want to communicate with you about the impending retirements of two administrators in our school district. Both Mr. Sipple and Mr. Glocke have shared with us their desire and timeline for retirement from our district. We accepted Mr. Glocke's retirement effective June 30, 2018 at our November 6th board meeting.

After having some discussions at the board level about replacing two key positions in the same year, the Board and Mr. Sipple discussed his staying for one more year. This would help the district more effectively transition the new 7-12 principal and give the board adequate time to do a comprehensive search for our new superintendent.

We are very pleased to announce Mr. Sipple has agreed to remain as our Superintendent through June 30, 2019. Our plan is begin the superintendent search process as early as September 2018.

Regarding the search process for the 7-12 principal vacancy, we will post the position beginning December 18, 2017. Our search will be state and nationwide to find the best candidate pool available. Our timeline has us completing the hiring process by early March.

As your representative school board members, we will do our best to attract and hire the best candidates for our school district. We believe given our outstanding reputation and our high standards, we will attract outstanding candidates.
