Wisconsin Virtual School Class Expectations

The following applies for students and families who participate in WVS Courses.

- Once a course is approved by BHS Administration a student will have the WVS class assigned to their schedule. The class will start with the Boyceville High School calendar semester start date. The class will end one week prior to the end date for BHS classes. This time is needed to complete necessary communication and grading requirements. If you are a senior and graduate in May, all of your WVS course work must be completed one week before graduation.
- 2. Once a course is approved, a student and their family have a 10 day trial period to decide if the course is an appropriate placement. A course can be dropped within a ten day window from registration. After that time frame of 10 days, a student and their family is committing to complete the WVS course for the semester.
- 3. All reported grades from WVS will be on your permanent record/transcript here at Boyceville High School. Students will receive credit the same way it is earned at earned at Boyceville High School, ½ credit for a semester and 1.0 credit for a full year course. All grades will be reported by semester (no quarter grades issued on report cards only one semester grade) from a student's WVS teacher and that grade will count in the student's grade point average and class rank at Boyceville High School.
- 4. All Parents and Guardians will receive a progress report directly from Wisconsin Virtual School allowing them to follow their student's progress. The parent and guardian email on this form will be used for this communication. If more than one parent or guardian would like the progress reports please note the additional name and email on this form.
- 5. All students who are taking a WVS class for the first time are required to complete an online Orientation class. The Orientation class will teach students how to complete their work, connect with their teacher and follow assignment due dates.
- 6. The Boyceville School District will pay for the cost of the WVS class for all students who earn a passing grade. If a student fails a WVS class, the family is responsible to pay for the entire cost of the class(es). Class fees are charged by semester. Credit Recovery is \$190.00 per class and all other courses are \$290.00 per class.
