Dear Graduating Senior,

The Boyceville Wrestling Club is sponsoring up to three \$250.00 scholarships.

All seniors in the Boyceville Community School District are eligible to apply. These scholarships will be awarded for any type of post-secondary education with preference going to students involved in the wrestling program and/or continuing their wrestling careers in college.

- A minimum high school GPA of a 2.0 is required.
- Include one letter of recommendation addressing the following:
Recommendation from someone in the community that can speak to your character (example: a member of the clergy, an employer, a community member, etc.).
- Complete the application cover page and essay questions.

The completed application must be submitted to the Boyceville High School Counselor by Friday, April 11th at 3:30 pm.

The scholarship check will be awarded to the student upon successful completion of the first semester of post-secondary education. This will be verified by mailing an official copy of the first semester transcript to the Boyceville Wrestling Club, Attention: Jaime Olson, 1003 Tiffany St., Boyceville, WI, 54725.
