#### About the Scholarship:

For 2025 the Boyceville Firefighters Assoc. is proud to announce that it is offering up to two scholarships in the amount of \$500.00 each, to graduating seniors from Boyceville High School. The scholarship(s) will be paid upon successful completion of the first semester and enrollment for the second semester in January/February. The winning scholarship recipient(s) will be responsible for sending a copy of his/her transcript and proof of enrolment paid tuition statement in the second semester to the Boyceville Firefighters Assoc. by the end of January to meet payment date. If the required documents are not received by the end of January this scholarship will be forfeited. Payments will be made to the recipient directly at their home address unless a request is made in writing to have it sent to another address. The recipient is fully responsible for these requirements. Recipient is also responsible for notifying the scholarship committee of any change in address. Requirements not met will void the award. All statements must be received before the payment week or the award is forfeited by the recipient.





#### Criteria for selection:

The applicant must be a senior who is graduating from Boyceville High School. You must be enrolled full-time in a technical college or university. This scholarship is not exclusively based on the applicant's financial need. No one factor alone will be responsible for an applicant receiving a scholarship. Factors, which are considered, are academic performance, written statements, neatness and care in completing the application, and the adult evaluations. Categories for the adult evaluations include but are not limited to school employees, employers, neighbors, mentors, etc. A minimum of (2) two adult evaluations are required but only one per any category. This means only one school employee, etc. It is your responsibility to ensure that your adult evaluations are complete and reach the scholarship committee on time.

#### Special notes about the application:

This application is designed to give you the best possible opportunity to present yourself and your qualifications to the scholarship committee. You should describe your personal career goals, academic and professional accomplishments. YOU MUST ANSWER ALL THE APPLICATION QUESTIONS, INCOMPLETE OR LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED. You are welcome to submit your application on your own form. Please type your application if possible. Late or incomplete applications as of April 18TH, 2025 will not be considered. You may mail, email, or drop off your completed application at the Boyceville Fire Hall. The school will be notified of the scholarship recipients in May 2025.
