 - b. List band related activities outside of school in the past 4 years (church, community, music camps, etc).
 - c. Share if you have received a W.A.M. (Wisconsin Ambassadors of Music) invitation, this is an honor, you do not have to go, participation is optional and a family decision.

Note: Do not put your name on either of these sheets (staple this cover sheet to both sheets).

JUDGING:

- Judging will be done blindly
- Content and neatness of essay will be scored (total of 10 points)
- School and outside of school music activities will be weighted and tallied
- An alternative applicant with the highest score will be selected in the event that the first candidate does not attend post secondary school or does not complete his or her first semester

We encourage all applicants to stay active in some form of music after graduation.
