- Must be enrolled with a minimum of five (5) credits and be in good standing at the school they are attending.
- Disbursement of \$500, will be awarded after all qualifications are met and with receipt of transcripts and verification of enrollment from eligible recipient.

All applications must be submitted by March 31.

The application requires an essay and letter of recommendation. Applicants who are the finalists may be contacted for more information. Scholarships will be awarded on or before May 1.
