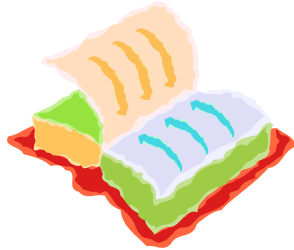

In Language Arts your child will:

- demonstrate increasing mastery of writing mechanics (grammar, punctuation, capitalization, spelling)
