In Language Arts your child will:

- use a variety of strategies and word recognition skills through guided reading
- infer the meaning of unfamiliar words in the context of a passage
- read aloud with age-appropriate fluency, accuracy, and expression
- identify and summarize main ideas and key points from literature
- use various forms of writing
- utilize the writing process (plan, draft, revise, edit, publish) with increasing skill
- orally communicate information, opinions, and ideas effectively

- use their knowledge of technology to enhance their formal writing pieces

In Math your child will:

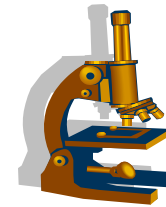
- know basic addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division facts

- understand and use fractional concepts
- find the median, mode, maximum, minimum, and range of a set of data
- read and write whole numbers to the millions
- identify decimals to the thousandths
- recognize and name geometric figures
- use a protractor and a compass
- use and interpret graphs
